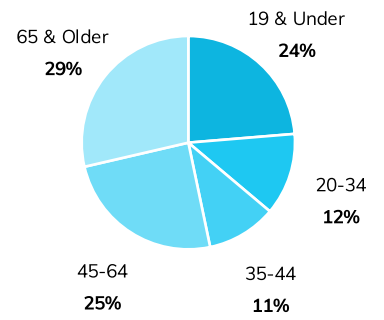

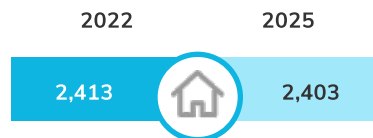

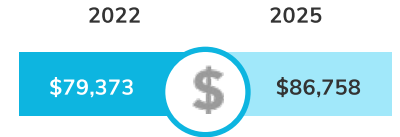

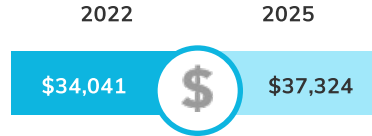
Median Household Income



Average Household Income



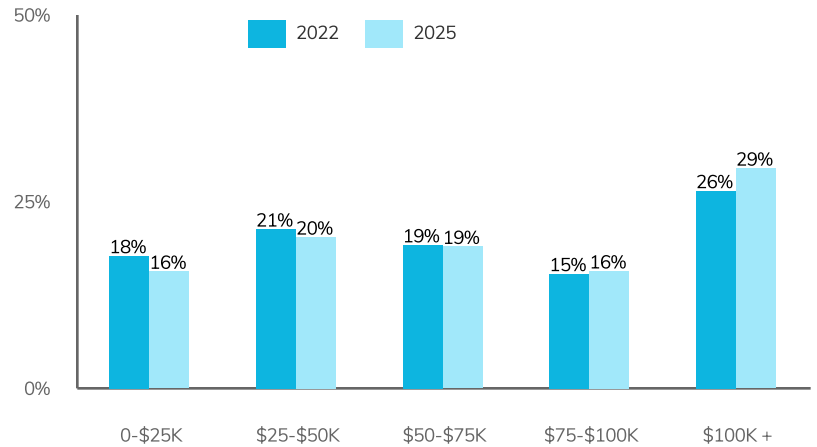
Per Capita Income

Description

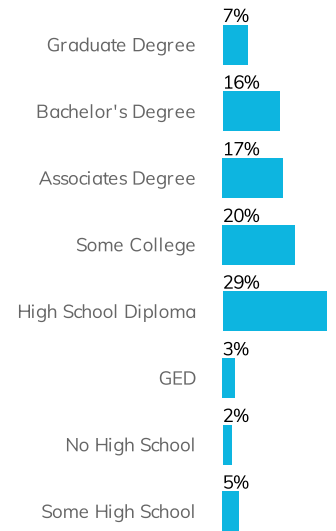
